

## Fall 2009 - USM Student Billing Information

Paper bills will be mailed to students beginning in mid July 2009.

Payment for Fall 2009 is due on August 15, 2009. Methods of payment include: payment in full, the award of sufficient financial aid to cover all Fall charges, third party agreement notification, or enrollment in a payment plan.

One paper bill will be mailed to all students who register for Fall classes before July 31, 2009.

Paper bills will not be mailed to any student who registers for the first time, adds classes to an existing schedule or incurs other campus charges after July 31, 2009. Students are responsible for reviewing online MaineStreet accounts to determine if a balance is due. All charges posted to a student account after August 15, 2009 must be paid when incurred.

Financial Aid awards (anticipated aid) can be found by logging on to the MaineStreet Student Center at any time. Paper bills will reflect anticipated aid. Actual financial aid funds will begin to post to student accounts on August 21, 2009. See the "financial aid" link for more information.

Refunds for eligible students will begin to disburse (via US Mail) on August 31, 2009. All student refund checks will be mailed to the "check" address entered by students on the MaineStreet Student Center. If the "check" address is not entered on MaineStreet by August 21, 2009 any refund check issued will be mailed to the student's "billing" address. Refund checks will not be mailed to dorm addresses.

Effective July 1, 2009 credit and debit card payments will be processed by Touchnet, an external processing company. Payments will be made online through the Mainestreet Student Center and cannot be accepted by USM staff in-person, through the mail or over the phone. A non-refundable convenience fee will be charged and VISA will no longer be accepted. See the "payment options" link for more information.
