### Supply List

1. A suiban or a low container for an ikebana flower vase. Any shapes of containers will do. A size is about 8'' in diameter or length. A depth is about 2''.
2. A kenzan or a frog for a flower holder. A size is about 3.5'' (l) x 3'' (w) for a square shape. A round shape is about 3.5'' in diameter.
3. Clippers
