

## Secondary (7-12) and Foreign Language (K-12) ETEP Curriculum

The following are the courses secondary and foreign language interns take during the internship portion of the ETEP Program. These courses are taken over the course of a ten month period: mid-May thru mid-August. The exact sequence of courses will vary, depending on site, concentration, and program option. All courses are 3 credit hours unless otherwise noted. Successful completion of these courses leads to a recommendation for a State of Maine General Elementary (K-8) Teacher Certification.
