

DES Program of Study

All DES students must complete and submit a written Program of Study before registering for the first semester of the junior year with the assistance of your advisor. It is intended to encourage you to tailor your academic studies based on your chosen concentration and personal interests. The Program of Study is submitted to the DES faculty for approval. After approval, the Program of Study may be amended with the approval of the advisor. Any significant changes, such as course substitutions, may require DES faculty approval.

Your Program of Study should be one to two pages--four paragraphs and one table. Each paragraph and heading should be based on the following:

I Introduction

- a. Who you are
- b. Your concentration
- c. Your status in the major (e.g., credit hours, transfer, etc.)

II Future Goals

- a. Describe your primary interests in your concentration
- b. Discuss your future goals (type of work, graduate school, location, etc.)

III Internship

- a. Discuss your internship plan (type, when, etc.)

IV Course Electives

- a. Identify 4 electives (or 37 credit hours for ESH majors)
- b. Discuss how these relate to Sections I, II, and III
- c. Present a proposed schedule in a table (see example below)
