Graduate assistantships are primarily offered by USM academic programs to outstanding in-coming or returning students. If you are interested in obtaining an assistantship, check off box 16 on your application. After acceptance, inquire directly to your program about possible assistantships. Your program may have an application form to complete for such positions. Many of these assistantships include both a stipend and a tuition waiver; however, some are stipend-only.

On occasion there are assistantships provided by other administrative or academic units at USM. These positions are usually stipend-only and do not include a tuition waiver. If you wish to be considered for these positions or made aware of other graduate student employment opportunities, send your resume to Janet Casey (jancasey@usm.maine.edu), Coordinator of Graduate Student Services, and information about jobs will be forwarded to you as they become available.
