USM Students in any of the following high risk
groups are encouraged to come:

- USM Students Living in USM Residence Halls or Fraternity Housing:
- USM Students under 65 years old with underlying chronic illnesses Such as asthma (or other lung disease), diabetes, cancer, weakened immune systems (including HIV/AIDS), heart disease (except hypertension); kidney disease or hepatitis; cognitive disabilities; neurologic and neuromuscular conditions (including muscular dystrophy and multiple sclerosis blood disorders)

All H1N1 vaccines will be **free of charge**

Other high risk groups will be offered vaccine as new supplies become available and dependent on Maine CDC guidance.
