Dear Parent/Guardian,

The University of Southern Maine has two health centers where students may go to receive care. If your son or daughter is under eighteen years of age, they will need permission from a parent or guardian before we can provide treatment. This permission covers routine health care. Emergency care will also be provided if the situation warrants.

The centers are staffed by Registered Nurses, certified Nurse Practitioners, and a Physician consultant. There is also an after-hours triage nurse available for students to talk to about their health concerns. Emergencies occurring after-hours or on weekends are managed by University Police, who arrange for rescue transport to a nearby hospital.
