<p>Keele University *Centrally located in England, about an hour south of Manchester and two hours north of London *Students can typically only study there for the spring or full year since the fall semester does not end until mid-January *Classes in a variety of subjects—can take up to two different subjects *All students pay for 16 credits at the in-state rate regardless of residency or actual number of credits taken *Minimum 3.0 GPA</p>	<p>http://www.keele.ac.uk Spring semester and full year programs</p>
<p>Kingston University *Located in the London suburbs, about 25 minutes from central London *Students can typically study up to two different subjects *On-campus housing is usually only available to full-year students *USM students pay a reduced rate for tuition and fees *Minimum 2.75 GPA *Offer a 5-week summer program with courses in the humanities.
