Criteria for the Madeleine Giguère Scholarship:

1. Students must be enrolled in a degree program at USM's Lewiston-Auburn College. Preference will go to those who have demonstrated an interest in French North American Studies and/or the local Franco-American community.
2. Students must have a grade point average of 3.0 or greater to qualify for the Scholarship.
3. Preference will go to students who can demonstrate a financial need.
4. Students who apply may not be eligible if they are eligible for tuition reimbursements.
5. Students must be enrolled at least half time for each semester of the school year in which the scholarship is rewarded.

A short essay is required expressing your interest in Franco-American studies and what your long-term goals are for the future. Your essay should include personal ambitions as well as professional goals. Finalists will be contacted for an interview.

Each application will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee at the Franco-American Collection. Deadline for submission April 15, 2008. Three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded annually.
