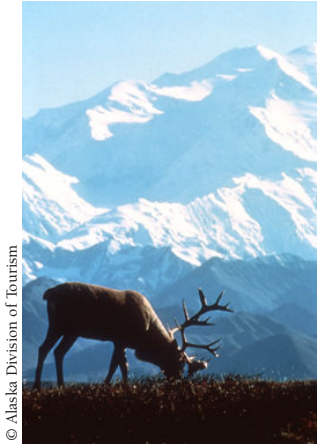


# Off to Alaska
