

Reporting a Problem...Who to call...

Emergencies

Situations requiring an immediate response from police, fire, and/or ambulance

Call U.S.M. Public Safety

Campus Phone: Dial 911

All other Phones: Dial 780-5211

On the Lewiston Campus, Call Lewiston Police

Campus Phone: Dial 9-911

All other Phones: Dial 784-6421

U.S.M. Public Safety will contact all necessary on and off-campus Emergency Responders.

Call Lewiston PD and THEN notify the Dean 753-6594 or 6594 from a campus phone

Examples of Emergencies:

Campus Crime in Progress (crime against a person and/or property)	Active Shooter Weapon on Campus	Suspicious Person
Imminent Suicidal Behavior	Severe Illness/Injury	Missing Person
Aggression/Physical Assault Threat of violence	Hate Crime	Fire/Explosion
Bomb Threat	Biohazard/Hazardous Spill Unusual Odor/Suspicious Package	Facilities Emergency Power Outage Natural Disaster
Crime near campus (to initiate campus safety alert - USM ALERT)	Unattended Death	Abuse/Neglect of a minor (required to report by Maine law)

Other Serious Situations

Situations that may not require immediate action to preserve life or property

These situations do require swift action by the University, a continuity of care, and may involve emergency responders at some point. **If in doubt call U.S.M. Public Safety; if on the Lewiston Campus call Lewiston PD and the Dean's Office.**

The contact will ensure that information about resources, accommodations, and complaint procedures are provided.
